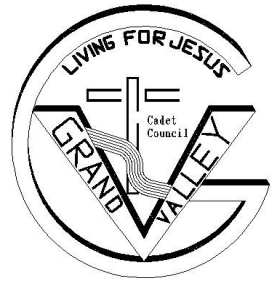




Grand Valley Cadet Council Newsletter
